Current Legislation to Review

- ➤ SB 1368/HB 971 Section 180.06, Florida Statutes, Interruption of Services revised to include garbage pickup services prohibiting a municipality or private company from charging for garbage pick-up services that are not rendered within a specified period.
- ▶ SB 1308/HB 1149 Section 403.706, Florida Statutes, Local government solid waste responsibilities revised to address contamination of recyclable materials in contracts for the collection, transportation, and processing of residential recyclable material.

Current Legislation to Review

- ▶ HB 879 Management of Storm-generated Debris and Solid Waste Revises definition of "recovered materials" to include certain wood, asphalt, & concrete materials; requires local governments to suspend exclusive contracts for collection, hauling, staging, or disposal of storm-generated debris & solid waste under certain conditions; prohibits local governments from entering into & extending such contracts after specified date.
- ▶ SB 348 Disposable Plastic Bags Defining the term "coastal community"; authorizing certain municipalities to establish pilot programs to regulate or ban disposable plastic bags; directing participating municipalities to collect data and submit reports to the municipal governing bodies and the Department of Environmental Protection, etc.
